




Market Summary

The stock market on Wednesday remained positive in majority part of the day and concluded the session in the green zone as overall trading activity strengthened. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 163,397.24 (1,704.75 points) and 160,564.85 (-1,127.64 points) respectively while closed at 163,188.53 by gaining 1496.04 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0079 against USD and closed at Rs 280.5609. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 30.899 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs18.504 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 635.18 million shares compared with Tuesdays's tally of 589.23 million. WTL was the volume leader with 47.8 million shares, losing Rs0.03 to close at Rs1.82. It was followed by HUMNL with 38.1 million shares, gaining Rs1.49 to close at Rs16.48 and DSLNC with 34.7 million shares, losing Rs0.01 to close at Rs7.92.


