


The stock market on Thursday surged past the 153,000 mark on Wednesday and concluded the session in the green zone amid strong sectoral performance and improving economic sentiment. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 153,411.05 (1,209.18 points) and 152,264.96 (63.09 points) respectively while closed at 152,665.72 by gaining 463.85 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.0395 against USD and closed at Rs281.6684. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs 46.022 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs17.980 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 952.68 million shares compared with Wednesday tally of 1,041.21 million. BOP was the volume leader with 99.5 million shares, gaining Rs0.99 to close at Rs18.36. It was followed by KEL with 45.3 million shares, gaining Rs0.08 to close at Rs5.34 and PIBTL with 38.6 million shares, gaining Rs0.53 to close at Rs13.44.


