



Market Summary

The stock market on Monday opened on a bullish note and concluded the session in the green zone amid growing optimism among investors over continuation of the buying spree. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 133,862.01 (1,912.95 points) and 132,467.12 (518.06 points) respectively while closed at 133,370.14 by gaining 1,421.08 points. PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.4972 against USD and closed at Rs284.2195. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs45.221 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs16.105 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 914.28 million shares compared with Friday day tally of 730.91 million. IMAGE was the volume leader with 48.1 million shares, gaining Rs3.08 to close at Rs36.32. It was followed by BOP with 42.5 million shares, gaining Rs0.21 to close at Rs11.87 and WTL with 36.9 million shares, gaining Rs0 to close at Rs1.55.


