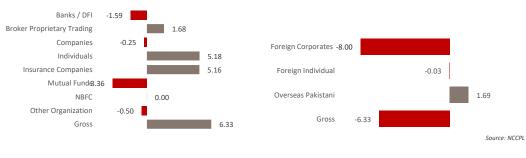

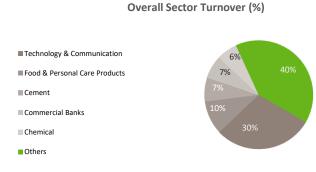
### **Market Summary**

The stock market on Wednesday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid investor's sentiment remained subdued. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 119,460.54 (884.66 points) and 118,148.64 (-427.24 points) respectively while closed at 118,536.52 by losing 39.36 points.PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0434 against USD and closed at Rs281.7162. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs41.864 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs14.209 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 605.06 million shares compared with Tuesday's tally of 680.41 million. PREMA was the volume leader with 38.8 million shares, gaining Rs4.08 to close at Rs44.84. It was followed by FCCL with 36.2 million shares, gaining Rs0.33 to close at Rs47.86 and SSGC with 32.4 million shares, gaining Rs3.28 to close at Rs36.07.

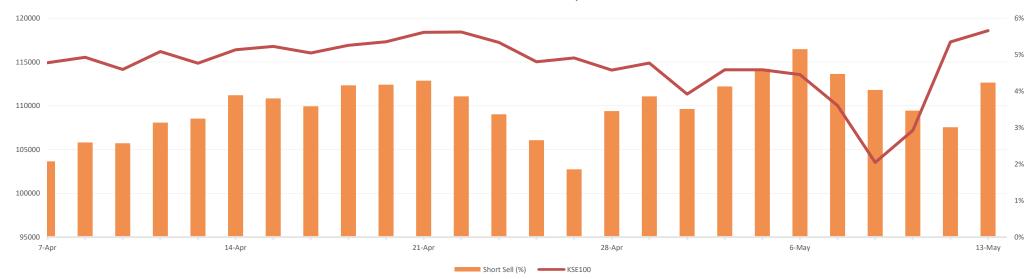
