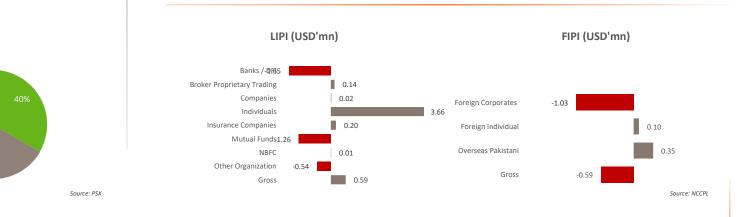
Market Summary

The stock market on Friday remained volatile throughout the day and concluded the session in the red zone amid profit taking by the investors. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 120,506.17 (544.26 points) and 119,541.15 (-420.76 points) respectively while closed at 119,649.14 by losing 312.77 points.PKR in today's interbank depreciated by Rs 0.0503 against USD and closed at Rs281.6646. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs28.987 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs14.388 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day decreased to 570.29 million shares compared with Thursday's tally of 695.23 million. PREMA was the volume leader with 44.6 million shares, gaining Rs0.51 to close at Rs49.83. It was followed by CNERGY with 32.3 million shares, losing Rs0.17 to close at Rs20.98.

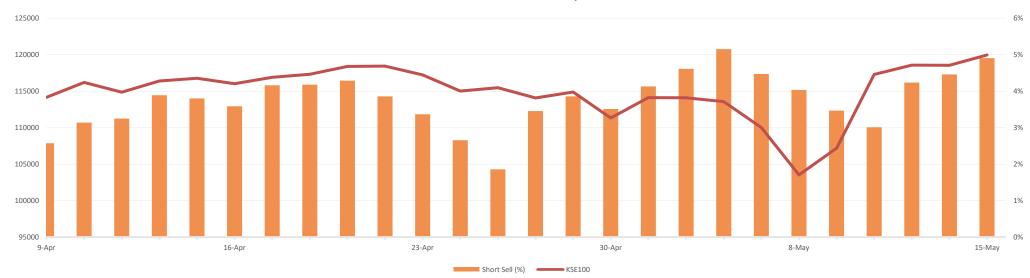
